

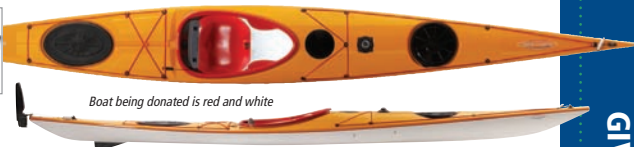
Go home a winner!
